General Rules for ISSFHK Fencing Championships 2018-2019

All matches will be fenced according to the Rules of the International Fencing Federation (F.I.E.) and Hong Kong Fencing Association.

Individual Competition

Three weapons Foil, Epee & Sabre will be fenced for Boys and Girls in Open grade: Boys Epee (BE), Boys Foil (BF), Boys Sabre (BS), Girls Epee (GE), Girls Foil (GF) and Girls Sabre (GS), six events in total.

Each School is allowed to enter up to and no more than 4 fencers in each event Each fencer may participate in one weapon only.

Registration

Schools are required to fill in the entry information for Individual Competition Each school must provide student ID Card or information for student identity

Equipment and Clothing

- Full fencing equipment consisting of mask, uniform (including fencing jacket, breeches and under plastron 350N), long socks, and glove that adequately cover the opening of the sleeves must be worn.
- Fencers' mask and uniform must comply with the standard EN13567:2002, i.e., at least 350N of the penetration resistance. Please refer to notice at http://www.hkfa.org.hk for details.
- Foil Fencers must use foil mask with conductive bib; and Sabre Fencers must use conductive cuff
- The Ground Supervisor has the discretion to disqualify any participant who does not comply with the equipment and clothing rules.

Safety Rules

- Masks should be in good condition, free from rust and with the bib attached.
- A Sword must NEVER be pointed at anyone who is not wearing a fencing uniform including a mask.
- Anyone who is not fencing must remain well clear of the piste while fencing is in progress.

Awards and Medals

- 4 medals will be awarded to Champion, Second and Co-Third players in each event. 6 golds, 6 silvers and 12 bronzes will be presented in total.
- Overall points will be counted for Boys overall and Girls overall for the ISSFHK overall Fencing Championship Flag.
